A sewer service charge is hereby imposed upon each lot, parcel of land, building or premises served by the system, or otherwise discharging sewage, including industrial wastes, into the system. Such sewer service charge shall be payable as hereinafter provided and in an amount determinable as follows:

(1) SURCHARGE AND SERVICE FEES. (Am. #27-99) The sewer service charge for any lot, parcel of land, building or premises within the corporate limits and for any lot, parcel of land, building or premises outside the corporate limits which is connected to the sanitary system shall, subject to sec. 29.10(5), be based upon the quantity of water used therein and the quality of wastewater generated as measured by the water meter or wastewater meter in use as follows:

- (e) <u>Surcharge</u>. A surcharge will be imposed on any user contributing extra strength waste, i.e., waste stronger than normal domestic strength waste in terms of concentration of BOD₅ suspended solids, and phosphorus. Surcharge rates appear in Section 29.12(1)(b).
- (f) <u>Charges to persons required to have a wastewater discharge permit.</u> Persons (including On-Site Waste Disposers) shall pay an annual charge according to the following schedule:
 - (1) Each categorical discharge monitoring point shall be assessed an annual fee of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

- (2) Each monitoring point governed by a local limit shall be assessed an annual fee of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00).
- (3) Where a discharge monitoring point is governed by both categorical and local limits, the higher of the two fees will be assessed, but not both.
- (4) Each On-Site Waste Disposer shall pay an annual fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per registered vehicle.
- (5) Persons holding a Zero Discharge Permit shall pay an annual fee of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).
- (2) REASSIGNMENT OF SEWER USERS. The Control Authority shall reassign sewer users into appropriate sewer service charge categories if wastewater sampling programs and other related information indicate a change of categories is appropriate.
